- The operations of the Company relate to only one segment viz. Electrical and Electronic products for two/three wheelers and engines.
- The Financial results have been reviewed & recommended by the Audit & Risk Management Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their meeting held on 2 October 30, 2019.

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- 3 During the period, the company has sold the land at Gurgoan and recognised the profit under other income amounting to Rs. 1,164 lakhs.
- Effective April 01, 2019, the Company adopted Ind AS 116 "Leases", applied to all lease contracts existing on April 01, 2019 using the modified retrospective method, which resulted in recognition of Right-of-use asset amounting to Rs. 521.91 lakhs and an equivalent lease liability. The effect of this adoption on the standalone and consolidated profit for the period and earnings per share is not material. 4
- Pursuant to The Taxation Laws (Amendment) Ordinance, 2019 issued on 20th September, 2019, corporate assesses have been given an option to apply a lower income tax rate with effect from 1st April, 2019, subject to certain conditions specified therein. The company is in the process of evaluating the impact of availment of the said 5 option, and accordingly, no effect in this regard has presently been considered in the measurement of tax expense for the quarter and period ended 30th September, 2019 and the consequent impact in the deferred tax as on that date.

A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing specified under Section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Attention is drawn to Note given under Statement of Cash Flows included in the Statement, which states that the statement of consolidated cash flows for the corresponding six months ended September 30, 2018, as reported in the accompanying Statement have been approved by the Parent's Board of Directors, but have not been subjected to review.

Nil for the guarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 respectively, total loss after tax of Rs. 0.26 lakhs and Rs. 10.28 lakhs for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 respectively and Total comprehensive loss of Rs. 0.26 lakhs and Rs. 10.28 lakhs for the guarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 respectively and net cash inflows (net) of Rs. 9.05 lakhs for the six months ended September 30, 2019, as considered in the Statement. The consolidated unaudited financial results also includes the Group's share of loss after tax of Rs. 80.75 lakhs and Rs. 132.49 lakhs for the guarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 respectively and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 80.75 lakhs and Rs. 132.49 lakhs for the guarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 as considered in the Statement, in respect of one associate, based on their interim financial results which have not been reviewed by their auditors. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, these interim financial results are not material to the Group.
