2.	Overview of the familiarization Programme		
	2.1	All Independent Directors are aware and further updated about their roles, rights, responsibilities	
		in the Company. The appointment letter issued to Independent Directors inter alia sets out the	
		expectation of the Board from the appointed director, their fiduciary duties and the accompanying	
		liabilities that come with the appointment as a director of the Company.	
	2.2	The company regularly communicates with all Independent Directors to provide detailed	
		understanding of the activities of the company including specific projects either at the meeting of	
		the Board of Directors or otherwise. The induction process is designed to build an understanding	
		of the company's business and the markets to equip the Directors to perform their role on the	
		Board effectively. Independent Directors are also taken through various business situations,	
		nature of the industry, business model etc by way of presentations and discussions.	
	2.3	Such programmes / presentations provide an opportunity to the Independent Directors to interact	
		with the senior leadership team of the Company and help them to understand the Company's	
		strategy, business model, operations, service and product offerings, markets, organization	
		structure, finance, human resources, technology, quality, facilities and risk management and	
		such other areas as may arise, from time to time;	
	2.4	The Company will circulate news and articles related to the industry on a regular basis and	
		provide specific regulatory updates from time to time;	
	2.5	The Company will conduct an introductory familiarisation programme / presentation, when a new	
		Independent Director is inducted on the Board of the company.	
	2.6	Independent Directors are given all the documents sought by them for enabling a good	
		understanding of the Company, its various operations and the industry segments of which it is a	
		part. Further, when required, they meet without the presence of the Company's Management	
		Personnel to discuss matters pertaining to the Company's affairs and put forth their combined	
		views to the Chairman and Managing Director.
